Analysis of time series: Causes of variation in time series data; Components of time series; Decomposition — Additive and multiplicative models; Determination of trend — Moving Averages Method and method of least squares (including linear, second degree, parabolic and exponential trend); Computation of seasonal indices by simple averages, ratio — -to-moving average, and link relative methods.
